



## **Transient Checklist**

The following are required upon arrival at the marina:

- 1<sup>st</sup> night paid in advance (non-refundable).
- State issued photo ID with current mailing address (or supplement)
- Current vessel insurance declaration (min. \$300k P&I Coverage)
- Current registration or USCG documentation
- Completed Transient Agreement (provided upon arrival)

Check in times for all vessels at the fuel dock:

8:00am-7:00pm April 15-Sept 14. 9:00am-5:00pm Sept 15-April 14. Check out time is 2:00pm – Late Check out 5:00 with approval.

All vessels are expected to be in good seaworthy condition and aesthetically presentable. The Dockmaster shall inspect and have final approval of all vessels entering the marina.

Please do not store flammables on deck or in bilge areas. We are located adjacent to the National Response Center headquarters. We sincerely want you to enjoy yourself during your visit, but we take spills or the potential for a spill seriously. Fuel containers may be stored in our fire cabinets and any hazardous waste may be disposed of upon arrival.
