

Privacy Policy

A. Personally Identifiable Information

1. A visitor who browses this Web site is not required to reveal any Personally Identifiable Information, such as name, address, or telephone number. Nor is such information collected passively. Our Web servers collect other information such as the make of a visitor's browser software and the Internet domain name of the location from which the visitor enters.
